The Mothers' Guild is leading a service opportunity helping

Caring for Friends, formerly known as Aid for Friends

The organization provides food and friendship to seniors, children, and adults in the 5-county Philadelphia region. This is one of the largest food banks and most comprehensive senior meal delivery program in the Greater Philadelphia region. The senior meal program serves over 28,000 clients, the majority of whom are homebound seniors and veterans.

So what is Our Goal?

On December 4th, 5th, & 6th we are asking HGP Families to prepare a meal together at home to donate to Caring for Friends.

Caring for Friends provides tins for meals, plastic bags to store them in, and labels. You provide the cooking skills, the contents, and the time to assemble the meals. Students can pick up the containers to store the meals at the Campus Ministry office starting November 18th.

Your meals should be delivered to *HGP on December* 7th at the *Mothers' Guild Christmas Drive Thru Meeting* 5:30PM ~ 8:00PM We will store the meals in the fieldhouse freezers and deliver them to Caring for Friends.
