- Students are reminded not to have exam related notes or books with them when they are taking their exam, unless they have been instructed differently by their teacher. Students may have a book for a subsequent exam with them underneath their chair, to use in the event that they finish early. All backpacks should be at the front or back of the room, with none in the aisles.
- Book return occurs with your subject teachers at their instruction. All government issued books must be returned in their original condition to your teachers. If the book is not returned, you must pay a book replacement fee (\$75) in order for your report card to be released and to be given access to PowerSchool once grades are finalized.
